## Service and Leadership at Hamilton Boys' High School

Hamilton Boys' High School boasts high levels of student and staff engagement in all fields of endeavour. Service and leadership opportunities abound.

### **HBHS Service Awards**

The award provides students with the opportunity to gain a Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum Premier Award in Year 13 for those who display outstanding service.

A challenging and rewarding programme of personal development, providing service to individuals and the community. The award is based on the belief that members of a community have a responsibility to each other and voluntary help is needed. It rests on the idea that service is a profoundly important part of intellectual development as well as a foundation of good citizenship.

### **SAFE**

SAFE is a volunteer group of senior students trained to keep students safe and to provide companionship and support. Students wear badges and are recognised with a service certificate.

### **Mentoring**

The school places great emphasis on mentoring students. A large number of staff help guide students by developing a supportive learning relationship and sharing their knowledge, wisdom and experience. Elite sports students, at risk students and academic students are involved in specific mentoring programmes.

Prefects and Year 13 students also mentor younger students helping them plan, set goals and provide support and reading mentoring to junior students who require assistance with reading.

### **Leadership**

Opportunities include Senior and Junior House Leaders, Tutor Group Leaders, Junior Prefects, SAFE members, Library Monitors, Environmentalists, Tutor Group Leaders and student readings at assemblies based on school crest values and habits of the mind. Seniors also assist with junior camps, captaining sports and cultural teams and coaching junior sports teams.

### **Prefects**

Year 13 students are selected as Prefects. Special positions of responsibility include Head Prefect, Deputy Head Prefect, Sports Captain and Arts Captain. Prefects are involved in the Academic, Cultural, Service and Sports committees, where they organise and support important school events, plan student activities and assist staff in the organisation of programmes throughout the year.

## The Co-curricular Life at Hamilton Boys' High School

Hamilton Boys' High School places a strong emphasis on co-curricular participation and achievement. The school strives to achieve balance between Academic, Cultural and Sporting endeavours. The co-curricular life of the school has an essential role in developing the character both of individuals and of the school through growth of pride, loyalty, self-esteem and confidence.

Hamilton Boys' High School provides extensive co-curricular activities and hundreds of sports teams for students of the school. These teams and groups give the opportunity for boys to meet challenges, learn teamwork, better themselves and strive to achieve goals. The school actively encourages all boys to participate in co-curricular activities and this is seen as complementary to the school's academic focus.
