Kaituna White Water Rafting

The Kaituna River is a rafter's dream – a 50 minute action packed ride down 11 wild rapids, 3 epic waterfalls, one of which is the highest rafted waterfall in the world – the world famous 7-meter Tutea Falls. All of this in a deep, usually warm water jungle canyon.

Indoor Snowboarding/Skiing

Spend a fun day at New Zealand's only indoor snow resort. Snowplanet offers skiing, snowboarding, all in one place, and all year round whatever the weather.
